# PROFESSIONAL MASTER'S

From an interdisciplinary view of Public Administration, the Professional Master's in Public Administration of the IDP (MPAP) is organized to meet the demands of different profiles of civil servants and other professionals that act directly or indirectly with public policies and government management.

MPAP is a *stricto sensu* master's degree, approved and recommended by CAPES, which favors the application of theoretical knowledge to the solution of problems related to formulation, monitoring and evaluation of public policies and government management.

The main objective of the Master is to provide professionals with a set of knowledge and techniques that allow them to perform more efficiently, effectively and effectively their job.

## TARGET AUDIENCE

The Master in Public Administration of EAB / IDP is aimed at civil servants and professionals from related areas of higher education who work directly or indirectly with the process of formulation, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and / or regulation of public policies and social programs. It is desirable that participants have minimal experience in carrying out activities related to government management process and / or public policies. Experience is valued in order to increase the quality of debates in the classroom, allowing greater exchange of experience among students and increasing the possibility emergence of innovative solutions for Public Administration.

## CURRICULAR FLOW

MPAP is organized based on the offer of 2 credit courses (40 hours /class), with 4 compulsory subjects and 7 optional subjects. There is also the forecast of 6 credits for the activities for the arrangement of the Final Paper / Dissertation. The regular course is developed in 2 academic years, with bimonthly offer of subjects. The disciplines are offered in meetings on Friday afternoons and evenings , and Saturdays, which allows interested parties to reconcile their participation in the master's degree with professional practice. Altogether, they are carried out 24 meetings of two days of classes (Friday afternoon / evening and Saturdays during the day).

## CASE STUDY

One of the main characteristics of MPAP is the teaching methodology, which, in addition to solid theoretical training, gives special attention to the analysis of case studies and practical applications of knowledge to public management. That way, it seeks to expose to the student, from the first semester, real examples of management techniques and innovative public policies implemented around the world. In addition, the curriculum has been designed to provide the student with complete and multidisciplinary training, involving the four main areas of knowledge necessary for a professional of excellence in the sector public: Public Administration, Political Science, Law and Economics.

## ACADEMIC STAFF

The main differential of MPAP is, certainly, the qualification of the academic staff, composed of professors who, in addition to standing out for their high and diversified academic qualification, are also characterized by playing roles at the highest levels of the public sector. This is a fundamental aspect of the program, since it allows exposing, analyzing and discussing with students the ways of applying the theoretical tools exposed in each of the disciplines to reality of Public Administration, which emphasizes the "professional" character of the course.

# MANDATORY DISCIPLINES

The MPAP disciplines are directly related to the area of “Contemporary Public Management” concentration. This area of concentration is based on the challenges faced by the Contemporary State in promoting the economic and social development. The core of compulsory disciplines is composed by four disciplines, which were formatted with the following objectives:

i) offer the master student the instruments of understanding and analysis and the functioning of the public sector from the perspective of four areas of knowledge which are complementary to each other (Administration, Political Science, Law and Economics) and

ii) offer a solid qualitative and quantitative basis of methodology applied to the analysis of Public Administration.

In this way, the aim is to train magistrates, prosecutors, public defenders, judiciary servants and lawyers to act as effective agents of professionalization and modernization of management in the Judiciary.
